Competition Number AP11

10 m TEAM AIR PISTOL SUMMER LEAGUE

Format Teams of 3. A Club may enter any number of teams.

Course of Fire 20 shots at 10 metres per team member per round.

(5 shots per card). 10 rounds per competition.

Period of Shooting April to September.

Targets NSRA Air 4/89 cards.

Pistols Must conform to N.S.R.A. Rule 9.2.3. The trigger must

support a 500 g weight.

Ammunition Must conform to N.S.R.A. Rule 9.2.6.

Prizes Winners, all Divisions - 3 County Medals & Certificate.

Competition Number AP12

10 m INDIVIDUAL AIR PISTOL SUMMER LEAGUE

Course of Fire 20 shots at 10 metres per round. (5 shots per card).

10 rounds per competition.

Period of Shooting April to September.

Targets NSRA Air 4/89 cards.

Pistols Must conform to N.S.R.A. Rule 9.2.3. The trigger must

support a 500 g weight.

Ammunition Must conform to N.S.R.A. Rule 9.2.6.

Competition Number AP13

10 m TEAM AIR PISTOL WINTER LEAGUE

Format Teams of 3. A Club may enter any number of teams.

Course of Fire 20 shots at 10 metres per team member per round.

(5 shots per card). 10 rounds per competition.

Period of Shooting October to March.

Targets NSRA Air 4/89 cards.

Pistols Must conform to N.S.R.A. Rule 9.2.3. The trigger must

support a 500 g weight.

Ammunition Must conform to N.S.R.A. Rule 9.2.6.

Prizes Winners, all Divisions - 3 County Medals & Certificate.

Competition Number AP14

10 m INDIVIDUAL AIR PISTOL WINTER LEAGUE

Course of Fire 20 shots at 10 metres per round. (5 shots per card).

10 rounds per competition.

Period of Shooting October to March.

Targets NSRA Air 4/89 cards.

Pistols Must conform to N.S.R.A. Rule 9.2.3. The trigger must

support a 500 g weight.

Ammunition Must conform to N.S.R.A. Rule 9.2.6.

Competition Number AP15

10 m INDIVIDUAL AIR PISTOL CHAMPIONSHIP

Format

To be shot in 2 stages.

Stage 1 will be shot in 4 classes (the competitors being

classified according to their average).

Stage 2 will consist of the top 10 shooters of Stage 1.

Course of Fire

40 shots - 4 shots per card, in each stage.

Period of Shooting

October to March.

Targets

NSRA Air 4/89 cards.

Pistols

Must conform to N.S.R.A. Rule 9.2.3. The trigger must

support a 500 g weight.

Ammunition

Must conform to N.S.R.A. Rule 9.2.6.

Prizes

 1^{st} Stage - County Medals for 1^{st} , 2nd & 3^{rd} in each class.

2nd Stage - Cloth Badge & Medal for the winner. County Medals for 2nd to 5th finalists.

20 yd TEAM PISTOL SUMMER LEAGUE

Format Teams of 3. A Club may enter any number of teams.

Course of Fire 20 shots at 20 yards per team member per round.

(10 shots per card). 10 rounds per competition.

Period of Shooting April to September.

Targets NSRA - PL15 cards.

Pistols .22 cartridge pistols or .177 / .22 air pistols may be used.

There is no trigger weight restriction for this competition.

Ammunition Air pistol pellets must comply with NSRA Rule 9.2.6.

Prizes Winners, all Divisions - 3 County Medals & Certificate.

Competition Number P22

20 yd INDIVIDUAL PISTOL SUMMER LEAGUE

Course of Fire 20 shots at 20 yards per round. (10 shots per card).

10 rounds per competition.

Period of Shooting April to September.

Targets NSRA - PL15 cards.

Pistols .22 cartridge pistols or .177 / .22 air pistols may be used.

There is no trigger weight restriction for this competition.

Ammunition Air pistol pellets must comply with NSRA Rule 9.2.6.

Competition Number P23

20 yd TEAM PISTOL WINTER LEAGUE

Format Teams of 3. A Club may enter any number of teams.

Course of Fire 20 shots at 20 yards per team member per round.

(10 shots per card). 10 rounds per competition.

Period of Shooting October to March..

Targets NSRA - PL15 cards.

Pistols .22 cartridge pistols or .177 / .22 air pistols may be used.

There is no trigger weight restriction for this competition.

Ammunition Air pistol pellets must comply with NSRA Rule 9.2.6.

Prizes Winners, all Divisions - 3 County Medals & Certificate.

Competition Number P24

20 yd INDIVIDUAL PISTOL WINTER LEAGUE

Course of Fire 20 shots at 20 yards per round. (10 shots per card).

10 rounds per competition.

Period of Shooting October to March.

Targets NSRA - PL15 cards.

Pistols .22 cartridge pistols or .177 / .22 air pistols may be used.

There is no trigger weight restriction for this competition.

Ammunition Air pistol pellets must comply with NSRA Rule 9.2.6.

Competition Number P25

20 yd INDIVIDUAL PISTOL CHAMPIONSHIP

Format To be shot in 2 stages.

Stage 1 will be shot in 4 classes (the competitors being

classified according to their average).

Stage 2 will consist of the top 10 shooters of Stage 1.

Course of Fire

30 shots - 10 shots per card, in each stage.

Period of Shooting

October to March.

Targets

NSRA - PL15 cards

Pistols

.22 cartridge pistols or .177 / .22 air pistols may be used. There is no trigger weight restriction for this competition.

Ammunition

Air pistol pellets must comply with NSRA Rule 9.2.6.

Prizes

1st Stage - County Medals for 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each class.

2nd Stage - Cloth Badge & Medal for the winner. County Medals for 2nd to 5th finalists.

Competition Number TP11

INDIVIDUAL 10 m STANDARD PISTOL AIR PISTOL SUMMER LEAGUE (half course)

Course of Fire

30 shots per round at 10 metres. (5 shots per card).

2 strings of 5 shots – each string in 150seconds. 2 strings of 5 shots – each string in 20seconds 2 strings of 5 shots – each string in 10seconds

10 rounds per competition

Period of Shooting

April to September.

Targets

NSRA Air 4/89 cards for 150 second string.

NSRA Air 10/97 cards for 20 & 10 second strings.

Where automatic turning targets are not in use, the timing will

be done using a stopwatch and verbal commands.

Pistols

A .177 air pistol, which has a magazine that can be loaded

with 5 pellets.

The trigger must support a 500g weight.

Ammunition

Must conform to N.S.R.A. Rule 9.2.6.

Prizes

Winners, all Divisions - A County Medal.

INDIVIDUAL 10m STANDARD PISTOL AIR PISTOL WINTER LEAGUE

Conditions as for Winter League except

October to March.

INDIVIDUAL ISSF 10 m AIR PISTOL STANDARD LEAGUE

Course of Fire

30 shots per round at 10 metres. (5 shots per card).

6 strings of 5 shots – each string in 10seconds

10 rounds per competition

Period of Shooting

Targets

NSRA Air 4/89 cards.

Where automatic turning targets are not in use, the timing will

be done using a stopwatch and verbal commands.

Pistols

A .177 air pistol, which has a magazine that can be loaded

with 5 pellets.

There is no trigger restriction for this competition.

Ammunition

Must conform to N.S.R.A. Rule 9.2.6.

Prizes

INDIVIDUAL 10 m SPORT PISTOL AIR PISTOL LEAGUE

Course of Fire

30 shots per round at 10 metres. (5 shots per card).

3 strings of 5 shots – each string in 5 minutes

3 strings of 5 shots – one shot at each facing of the target. Targets are faced for 3 seconds and edged for 7 seconds.

Where a single shot pistol is used the targets will be edged for

12 seconds to allow for re-loading.

10 rounds per competition

Period of Shooting

Targets

NSRA Air 4/89 cards for 5 minute string.

NSRA Air 10/97 cards for 3 second shots.

Where automatic turning targets are not in use, the timing will

be done using a stopwatch and verbal commands.

Pistols

A .177 air pistol.

The trigger must support a 500g weight.

Ammunition

Must conform to N.S.R.A. Rule 9.2.6.

Prizes

GENERAL RULES

LABELS

These are to be stuck on the **FRONT** of the cards, at the top, by a club official prior to shooting.

Shooters who have entered both the team & individual leagues will shoot in the team league only and that score will count for their individual league results.

TNESSING Only persons that qualify under N.S.R.A Rule 7.5 may act as a witness. The duties of the witness are detailed in N.S.R.A Rule 7.6

Particular attention must be paid to checking that:

- 1. The appropriate stickers are affixed to the cards prior to shooting.
- 2. The shooter's name is printed on the card prior to shooting.
- 3. The shooters sign their cards when shooting is complete.

The witness shall then without delay, sign and date each card with the date of shooting.

UNSIGNED & UNWITNESSED CARD WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
